The project was split into two sections, 481km for the NT side and 142km for the Qld section in which Spiecapag won and executed. The project construction execution timeframe started in June 2017 and was completed in Jan 2018 with a total employee engagement on the project of 338.



Findings

Indigenous engagement and cultural heritage was one of the most critical factors in the approval and during the execution of the project.

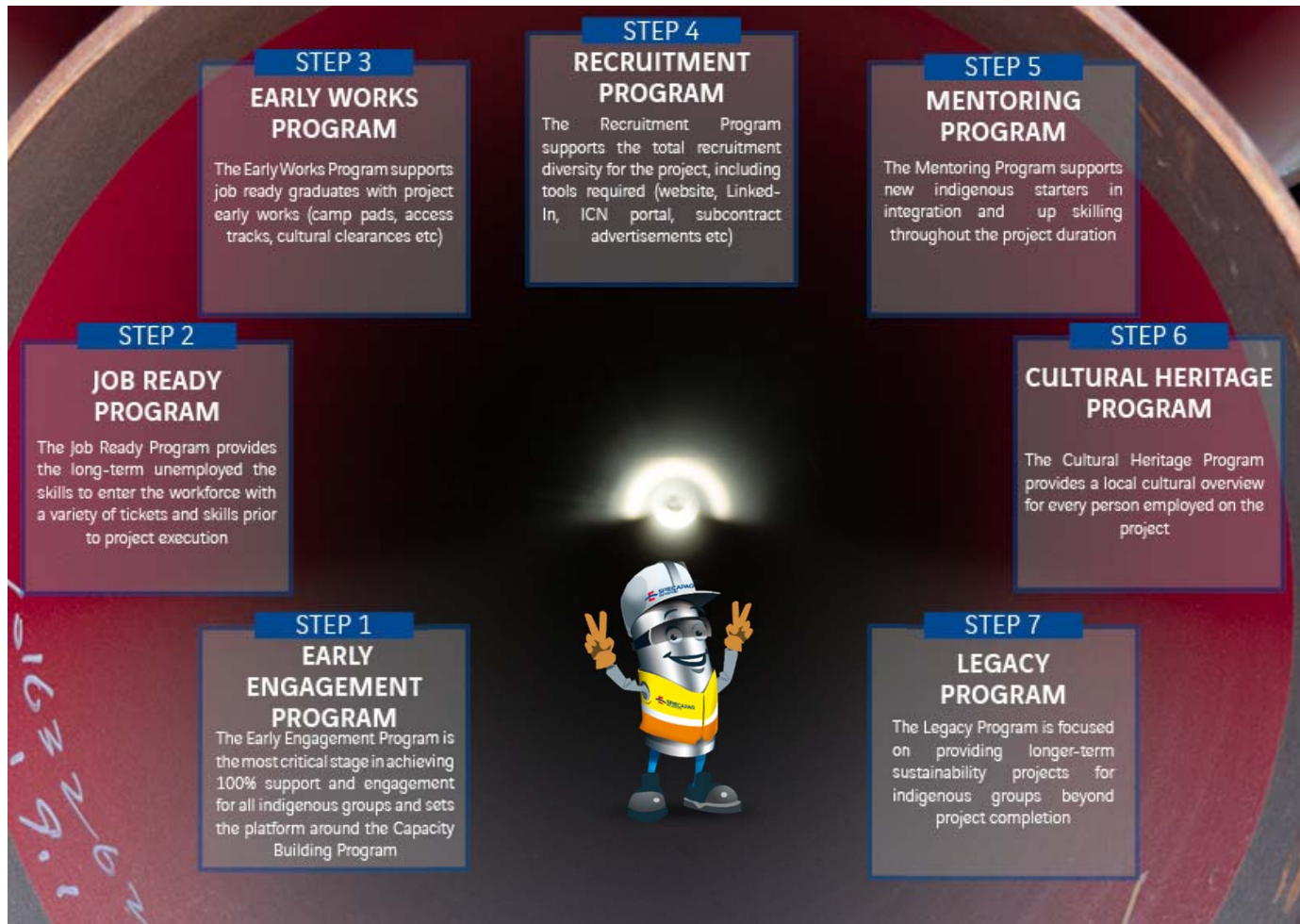
Maximising the employment of people from the regions, with a focus on Indigenous people and businesses

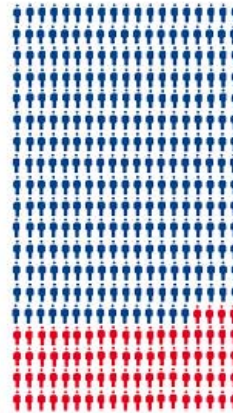


Achievements



Kelvin Gibson has been working for Spiecapag as a labourer on the NGP Project in Mount Isa.

Kelvin has been successfully selected to attend a 6-week Gas Operator Training Program, giving him the skills to work as an entry level Gas Operator.



The project engaged over 80 indigenous personnel on the project, making up over 22% of the total work force. The Industry Standard for Indigenous engagement is 5%



Spiecapag assigned over 19% of the Sub-contract spending on supporting Indigenous Sub-contractors. The Industry Standard for Indigenous Sub-contracts is 5%
