2017 IPLOCA Scholarships

- □ Over 190 candidates applied by 27 January deadline
- ☐ 139 met the eligibility requirements
- ☐ Twenty students received scholarships of USD 4,500 each
- Where possible two scholarships are awarded to students with links to Regular Members in each IPLOCA Geographic Region
- ☐ Four scholarships are awarded to students linked to Associate Members
- □ Three accommodations were made due to a lack of eligible applicants from Europe Mediterranean and only one applicant from Europe Northwest


