# CSR Initiative : Findings

During the course of execution of Paradip Hyderabad pipeline project (Group A: 18” x 315 km & 16” x 290 km) of Indian Oil Corporation Ltd (IOCL) in the Indian state of Odisha; the Project Team learnt about the **Taratari Balika Vidya Niketan** (School for orphan girls). The school is located in Nilagiri village, in the Balasore district, Odisha, India.

The Team saw the existing dreadful condition of the school building and the difficulties faced by the large number of female students due to inadequate unhygienic living space. The poor hygienic facilities was a leading cause of spread of diseases among the young girls.

The Project team in consultation with the Division Management decided to lend support to the girls.

# CSR Initiative : Solution

The Company decided to provide financial assistance for the construction of Dormitory Buildings along with toilets for the 50 female resident students of Taratari Balika Vidya Niketan (school for orphan girls).

36,700 USD was handed over to Mr. Bikash Ranjan Jena, Head Master of the school by the Mr. P C Chaubey, Executive Director, IOCL on behalf of the Company on 4<sup>th</sup> January 2019.
