

Vehicle interior poses risks for epidemic due to its small volume, number of passengers and multiple contact points. Therefore, we recommend you pay attention to the following:



- If there is a passenger in the vehicle with you, use a mask and make sure that he or she sits in the right rear seat to maintain social distance.
- Do not forget to frequently disinfect contact points, such as door handles, window opening buttons, seats, steering wheel, gear, trunk lid, touch screen, climate control buttons, etc.
- During and after your trip, open the windows instead of using the air conditioner and ventilate your vehicle more frequently.
- The internal mechanism of the air conditioners are suitable for the formation of moisture, which can create a suitable environment for fungi, bacteria and germ housing. Therefore, make sure air conditioner maintenance is done timely.
- Keep disinfectant in the vehicles and use it regularly while getting on and off the vehicle.
- Keep disposable wet wipes in the vehicle.
- Do not keep packages, trash, etc. inside the vehicle or in the trunk, which may be a breeding ground for germs.
- Finally; smoking creates an extra risk for COVID-19; in addition to being prohibited by law as well as Project rules.
