- To follow the established Codes of Conduct set out by the industry and others with respect to working within a free and competitive market.

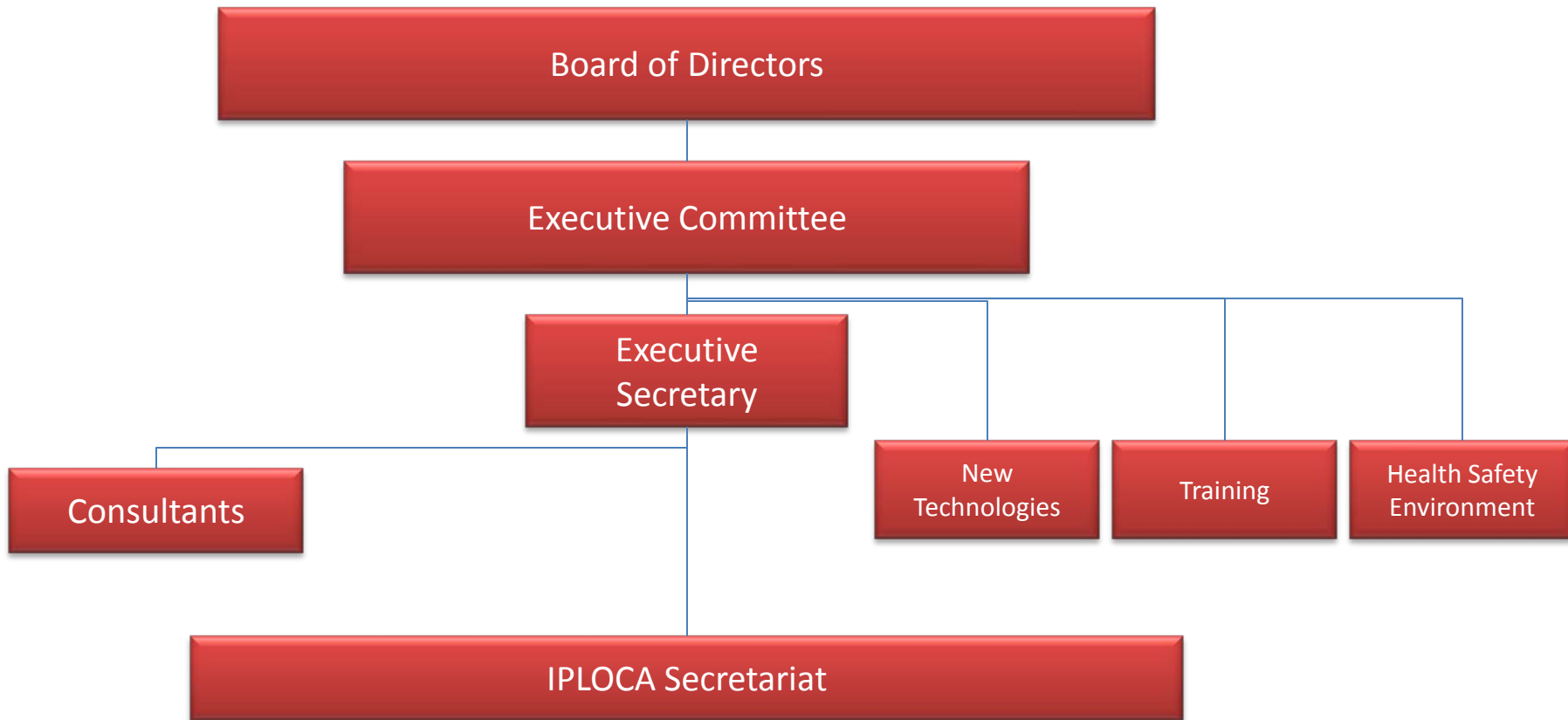
